We seek to identify and promote activities that prepare young people with insight, confidence and skills for a future Scotland that may not currently be addressed through formal education

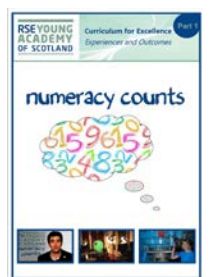
Future ambitions
